The current procedure is to fully inform Users during the course of change in line with a standard business process.</p> <p><u>History of Progression through GCRPs, Working Group and/or Consultation</u></p> <p>The proposed modification was presented to the GCRP members at the GCRP meeting #28, 8th June 2011.</p> <p><u>Summary Note of any Objections to the Recommended Change from GCRP Members or Consultation Responses</u></p> <p>No objections or concerns were raised.</p> <p><u>Outcome of any GCRP Meeting Actions relating to the Recommended Modification</u></p> <p>The GCRP members agreed to recommend the modification to the CER.</p>
	<p><u>Recommended Modification Proposal</u></p> <p>The following is the proposed changes to the Grid Code as recommended by the GCRP members. Any proposed text is highlighted in blue and any deleted text is highlighted in red strike-through.</p> <p>OC7.2.6.2 If the NCC is to be moved to a different location the TSO shall ordinarily notify Users as soon as practicable after the decision to move has been made, and not less than seven (7) days prior to the move, but in the event of an emergency it may instead notify Users as soon as practicable after the move.</p>
IMPLICATION OF NOT IMPLEMENTING THE MODIFICATION	The Grid Code will not be aligned with current practice.
